Landscape architect Mark Grantham, evaluated the site's water problems, proposed a package of environmentally sound solutions, and guided the construction of several projects at the Van Till Family Farm and Winery's patio and gardens. These projects are applicable to rural and urban gardens.

Relive these projects as Mark explains, through "power point", the phases of development, and then steps outside, so you can see and experience the completed projects and see how each project created a positive impact on the landscape environment.

Chris Veach will teach you to identify and treat harmful pests in your garden using the least toxic appropriate method. Genetic, cultural, mechanical, biological and as a last resort, chemical controls are discussed. The use of beneficial insects is emphasized. 99% of the insects in your garden are beneficial!

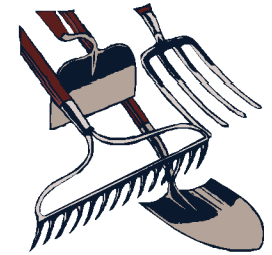
